## How to Join Council

Revision 2 – 1st September 2008

### Background

The Council of ACT Motor Clubs was incorporated in 1985 and represents nearly [60 motor clubs](#) in the ACT and surrounding region. There are more than 5000 members of vehicle clubs and approximately 2000 vehicles owned by club members. The interests of member clubs is wide and varied, so CACTMC continues to grow with "new member" clubs - [JOIN NOW](#).

### SUBMITTING YOUR APPLICATION FOR AFFILIATION

Collate the following items and submit them to the Council as your application for affiliation:

1. The Club's Constitution;
2. A list of the Club's executive committee including names, addresses, email addresses and contact numbers;
3. A copy of the minutes of the general meeting authoring the club to join Council - this must include a list of the members present at the meeting;
4. A written statement of the types of activities to be conducted by the club
5. A statement that the club will abide by the Council's Constitution.

Your application will then be presented to the Council for approval in accordance with Clause 2.2(2) of the constitution

The Council will notify you in writing of the outcome of your application.

Note: Affiliation with Council does not provide immediate access to CRS. Newly affiliated Clubs need to contact the Council Registrar to arrange a briefing on the Club Registrar procedures and obligations. Once a Club Registrar has been briefed they can obtain their Club CRS number and the CRS stamp (current stamp cost \$55).
